**LOCAL VIRGINIA BEACH COMPANY PROVIDING RELIEF SUPPORT TO GULF COAST**

Virginia Beach, VA, 07 Sep 2005 - SCG International Risk, headquartered in Virginia Beach, has partnered with London Bridge Baptist Church to donate needed manpower, construction and survival supplies to the victims of Hurricane Katrina.

Within hours of the hurricane's impact SCG personnel began planning a response out of the company's Memphis, TN office in coordination with the Red Cross. SCG sent in personnel to scout safe routes, provide security and assess what was most needed by the victims of the storm.
